How can I travel while on OPT?

You are eligible to travel while you are on OPT. In order to do so you must have the following documents in order to gain re-entry into the United States:

- ✓ Valid Passport
- ✓ Valid Visa
- ✓ Endorsed I-20 document (I-20 must be signed within 6 months of travel re-entry date)
- ✓ Valid EAD card (Employment Authorization Document)
- ✓ Valid Employment Letter

Health Insurance while on OPT:

It is important to note that it is highly recommended that you purchase a health insurance plan while on OPT. Medical costs can be extremely expensive and your Adelphi insurance will no longer be viable once you complete your program. You should purchase a private plan.
